

Victorian Hill Climb Classes for 2026

5.1 All classes in the VHCC, as listed in 5.2 of these regulations, will follow the National Speed Event Classes, Circuit Race Appendix classes and 5th Category Groups as published in the Motorsport Australia Manual, save for the separation of drive type (2wd & 4wd).

5.2 The Victorian Hill Climb Championship classes are:

1ST CATEGORY: RACING CARS

- A1 - Formula Vee
- A2 - Formula Ford 1600 or Formula Ford Duratec
- A3 - Formula Libre - up to 1300cc
- A4 - Formula Libre - 1301 to 2000cc
- A5 - Formula Libre - 2001cc and Over

2ND CATEGORY: SPORTS CARS

- B1 - Sports Cars - 2WD - Clubman up to 1600cc
- B2 - Sports Cars - 2WD - Open/Closed up to 2000cc
- B3 - Sports Cars – 2WD – Open/Closed 2001cc and over
- B4 - Prod Sports 2B & 2F up to 2000cc
- B5 - Prod Sports 2B & 2F 2001 and over

3RD CATEGORY: SEDANS

- C1 - Sports Sedans – 2WD – up to 2000cc
- C2 - Sports Sedans - 2WD - 2001cc and Over
- C3 - Sports Sedans - 4WD All
- C4 - Time Attack – All
- C5 - Improved Production – 2WD – up to 2000cc
- C6 - Improved Production – 2WD – 2001cc and over
- C7 - Improved Production - 4WD All

- R1 - Limited Modified Road Car up to 2000cc
- R2 - Limited Modified Road Car 2001cc and over
- R3 - Limited Modified Road Car 4WD All
